

COVID-19 Update – 1 Jan 2022

Vaccination Pass Requirement

At Camp Elsdon we are committed to the wellbeing and safety of our customers, staff, and contractors. To this end, in line with health and safety expectations, and considering the coming summer where camps and holiday parks across the country are going to be busy, in line with the majority of other campgrounds and holiday parks across NZ, using the MBIE guidelines, we have conducted a risk assessment of our environment.

Based on the outcome of that assessments we have implemented a no vaccination / no stay policy for a determined period, commencing from 1st January 2022. The decision whether or not to introduce a vaccination policy is based on a number of factors including the range of facilities and amenities offered, the layout and scale, the special nature of our camp users and expected occupancy levels over the coming months. Other considerations, like the presence of immuno-compromised people on site, may also influence the decision making.

The Vaccination Certificate Requirements applies to stays from 1st January 2022 until further notice.

All guests over the age of 12 years and 3 months, arriving after 1st January 2022, will have to show a valid vaccination certificate or official exemption at the time of check-in. Anyone unable to show either of these will be declined entry to the park.

We have additional guidelines around what is expected on arrival and during your stay including asking all campers and visitors to scan in via the COVID tracer app or manual system provided, wear masks where and when directed and social distance as practicable when asked to do so. All guests are expected to practice good personal hygiene (hand washing, not travelling if anyone in the party is unwell etc.).

We have enhanced cleaning regimes in place and offer sanitisation in appropriate areas of the camp.

We kindly ask that all campers and visitors show respect to staff at the camp. These are challenging and stressful times for all of us and our staff will be doing their best to deliver the service levels you are accustomed to and keep everyone safe at the same time. Rude and / or abusive behaviour towards staff, and / or other guests will not be tolerated and may result in cancellation of your booking and you will be requested to leave the camp.
